

RESOLUTION NO. 21-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIDGEPORT, WASHINGTON, SETTING THE DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING THE CITY COUNCIL'S INTENT TO ASSUME THE RIGHTS, POWERS, FUNCTIONS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE BRIDGEPORT TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bridgeport has adopted Ordinance No. 669 creating the Bridgeport Benefit District with the same boundaries as the City limits;

WHEREAS, Chapter 36.74 RCW authorizes a city to assume the rights, powers, functions and obligations of a transportation benefit district established by a city; and

WHEREAS, in order to assume the rights, powers, functions, and obligations of a transportation benefit district established by a city, the city legislative body must adopt an ordinance or resolution indicating its intention to conduct a hearing concerning the assumption of such rights, powers, functions, and obligations; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to identify the time, date and place for a public hearing on the proposed assumption of the rights, powers, functions and obligations of the Bridgeport Transportation Benefit District; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance or resolution of intention must be published at least two times during the two weeks preceding the scheduled hearing in newspapers of daily general circulation printed or published in the city in which the transportation benefit district is to be located; and

WHEREAS, as authorized by RCW 36.74.020, the City Council desires to schedule a hearing to consider an ordinance authorizing the City to assume the rights, powers, functions, and obligations of the transportation benefit district.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIDGEPORT, WASHINGTON DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Hearing Date. The City of Bridgeport Council will hold a public hearing on the proposed assumption of the rights, powers, functions and obligations of the Transportation Benefit District on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2021, at 7:00 PM. The hearing will be held at the Bridgeport City Council Chambers at 1206 Columbia Ave, Bridgeport, Washington. All persons interested may appear and be heard.

Section 2. Publication. This Resolution shall be published at least once during the ten days preceding the scheduled hearing, in the official newspaper of record for the City of Bridgeport.
