YARD SALE REGULATIONS

- ___ 1. Yard sales are limited to 3 per address per calendar year, lasting no more than 3 days at a time and held a minimum of 30 days apart.
 - ___ 2. Yard sale permits must be obtained before items are offered for sale to the public. Items for sale must be used merchandise.
 - ___ 3. Yard sale signs are permitted only on your own property and be removed immediately after the sale.
 - ___ 4. Yard sales must be conducted in a manner that does not present a danger to the public or to the property. Trash/unsold items must be removed immediately after the sale.
 - ___ 5. All items offered for sale must be arranged as not to interfere with emergency operations of the fire and police departments and health officials.
 - ___ 6. No group or individual may operate a second-hand store with a yard sale permit; this requires a business license, and is subject to zoning restrictions.

- ___ 1. Se permite tener 3 ventas por año. No pueden durar más de 4 días y tiene que haber mínimo 30 días de separación.
- ___ 2. Necesita obtener un permiso antes de tener la venta y solo se puede vender mercancía usada.
- ___ 3. Los carteles, letreros, etc. para promover la venta no se pueden poner en los postes de la luz y solo se permiten en la propiedad donde se va a realizar la venta.
- ___ 4. Los artículos deben tener cierto orden para que no interfieran o representen una amenaza al público o la propiedad. La basura o lo que no se vendió debe ser recogida en cuanto se termina la venta.
- ___ 5. Todo lo que se vende debe estar en orden para que no interfiera con el sistema de emergencias, bomberos, policía o departamento de salud.
- ___ 6. Ningún grupo o persona puede usar este permiso para una venta de segunda. Si va a tener un negocio de segunda debe obtener una licencia y verificar en que zona de la ciudad es permitido tenerlas. Para más información puede llamar a la oficina de la ciudad al 509.686.4041.
